Dear Partners in the Lord,

What a joy it is to partner with you as we serve our Savior here in South Africa. We have been extremely blessed and busy as God is working in amazing ways.

We just completed our winter camps. Seventeen of our youth attended and two of our young adults counseled this year. Four of our youth trusted in Christ and two of them came forward for assurance of their salvation. Our counselors also were blessed to see some youth from another church trust in Christ as they shared the gospel with them. The picture at the top is of the children and counselors who went to camp.

We have also seen 8 children from children’s church that meets in Fisantekraal trust in Christ as well as 6 youth since our last prayer letter.

It has been amazing seeing God use our people to share the gospel. Recently Alec set up a meeting with a man named Sean, a police officer in Fisantekraal. Alec had been sharing the gospel with him, but he had some additional questions. Alec and I met with him and answered his questions. After some

discussion, Sean wanted to trust in Christ as his Savior. Please pray for him as he grows in Christ.

We recently had a musical group from Bob Jones University come and minister at our church and in the children's church time in FIsantekraal. They played music, interacted with the children and shared several testimonies. The leader of their group shared the gospel with the children. Although, none of the children responded to the gospel that day, a security guard at the centre where we were meeting, Alakhe, heard what he said. One of our ladies, Siphokazi, noticed that Alakhe looked troubled and talked with her afterwards. She then went and got Terry and they spoke with her for quite some time. Jim was asked to come and answer a few questions, and then Alakhe prayed and trusted in Christ as her Savior. She and her husband Siphwiwe have been attending church and our Tuesday night Bible Study in the township. God is so amazing!

One of the ladies who attends Bible Study, Analisa, had questions so she came to our home one day. We were able to answer her questions and share the gospel again with her and she trusted in Christ.

We have been working on getting the ABWE Story of Hope Bible Study translated into Xhosa. It has been completed and we just had the first printing. Please pray that God would use this Bible Study to reach many for Christ. We will be making this available to all of our missionaries and church partners to use in their outreach to the Xhosa people.

We had explained about our 1997 Honda in our last prayer letter. It has had a long, good life which sadly has come to an end. The transmission went out and we had to sell it for parts. Right after we sold it, the bakkie (pick-up truck) blew a head gasket. We were able to use the money we got for the Honda to pay for the repairs on the bakkie. We have been raising money to purchase another car from missionaries who are retiring in December. We will be getting by with the bakkie until then. We will be returning to the States for a short furlough. We will fly out of South Africa on October 10, 2017, and then return to South Africa on January 25, 2018. We have a full Sunday schedule visiting our supporting churches. We may have some weekdays available if any of our supporting churches who have not scheduled with us already would like us to come. We are so grateful for your prayers and support for the ministry here. We are truly blessed!
