In April of 1971 my grandmother sent my cousins and I to the Good Friday service at a little Baptist church in that same district where I was born. We waited for about two hours for the church building to be opened but unfortunately no one came to conduct service that night. Therefore, we went back home without knowing what a worship service is all about. Out of curiosity I went back to that same church on Easter Sunday. I enjoyed the service and continued to attend church regularly. On October 24, 1971, at the age of 11 years old, I responded to the call of God to salvation and began my Christian lifestyle. I based my salvation experience on Romans 10: 9, 10, & 13. I was baptized on March 26, 1972. Since my initial day of salvation, my relationship with Christ has grown and developed into a life of spiritual maturity, resulting in practical, productive and a purposeful Christian witness. I was called of God to the Pastoral ministry in May, 1981, and have been involved in this same ministry until this present time. I am driven by a supreme and over-reaching passion of His glory. Through the proclamation of the Gospel of God in words and deeds, I desire to see the worship of God spread to all the nations of the world."

Please join us in praying for this pastor as he faces serious problems with both of his eyes, resulting in some loss of vision, treatments by an eye doctor, and possibly requiring surgery. He is also in a difficult financial situation. Pastor and his wife, Dorothy, and their two adult children have lived in Grenada for 15 years.
